- Understand where, from whom and how to get help outside of the home.
- Recognise that some frictions at home can be defused with a little bit of thought.

Starter:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Refer back to Lesson Plan 1 – discussion on problems at home and how to resolve them. • Discuss what could happen if the issues were not resolved. • Give a personal example: ‘Amie was so fed up with the rules at home that she packed a bag and went to her friend’s house.’ 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children’s work from Lesson Plan 1 • Interactive White Board • www.crisis.org.uk/downloads.php/1082/conflictinthehomeKS2LP2.ppt
Activity 1: Asking for Help	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask the students to work in small groups and list the people they think they could turn to for help. (eg. Teacher, grandparents, friends parents etc.). • Class discussion of content. • List all reasonable possibilities on the board. 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 side A4 per group • Interactive White Board • www.crisis.org.uk/downloads.php/1082/conflictinthehomeKS2LP2.ppt
