Where are the centres and what time do they open?

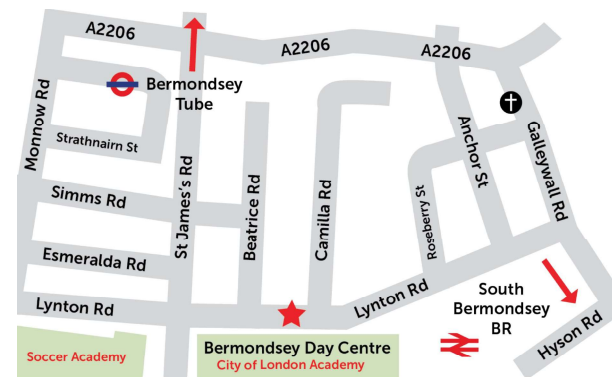
