"The Street Link" update


- The new website is working- kind of...
- https://thestreetlink.org.uk/
- There is a massive increase in referrals
- Last week there were 67 street link alerts for the borough of brent.
- Historically we would have around 3 StreetLink referrals a day
- Rapid Response Team
- 2/12 Saturday they had 70 alerts to visit (across their patch)
- The local team has seen an increase in referrals.



Annual Rough Sleeping Estimate

- Estimate meeting with a spotlight count
- Tuesday 21/11/2023-22/11/2023
- It's a single night figure
- 23 people counted in 2022
- 33 in total in 2023 (unofficial)

SWEP (Severe Weather Emergency Protocol)



- In cold weather- 0 degrees or below. (met office)
- This is triggered by the Greater London Authority
- SWEP specific outreach shifts 7 days a week
- Opening of emergency bedspaces across London
- Not linked to local connection
- Not linked to immigration status
- Chain Verified and actively bedded down
- Home office accommodation- no notices
- Local inbox is SWEP@brent.gov.uk

SWEP Bedspaces

Local

- End of 2023, 10 male bedspace, 2 women spaces. All shared space
- Beginning 2024- an additional 8 local bedspaces will open at crisis skylight
- 20 local bedspaces in total from start of 2024.

Regional

- There are some spaces across the 7 west London boroughs.
- These are more adhoc and can be anywhere within the 7 boroughs.
- After Christmas-Winter shelter/ Skylight in brent will have 2 regional bedspaces

Pan London

Rebuilding lives

St Mungo's Ending homelessness

- Run by NSNO St Mungo's
- Are located across London
- A mix of shared and hotel provision.
- These provisions open and close with need.
- Can't guarantee a brent bedspace for clients.
