



Tracy's story

"I was living in the same house for 14 years, and then the landlord said he's selling it. With the help of the law centre, we fought it for a while. But, we got the eviction. It was horrible to think: 'Now what? What am I going to do?'"

"So I went to the council and ended up in a hotel and then a hostel. That's where I met Crisis.

"I started getting my confidence back and going on every course I could: maths, IT, drama.

"I go to college as well. I want to work in some sort of support role so I've been doing the mentoring and drug and alcohol awareness courses.

"And, I've got my own flat now!"

"I wouldn't even know myself if I looked back a year. I was a nervous wreck. Now I'm larger than life and twice as ugly.

"There's no stopping me."

Crisis supports people out of homelessness for good. We do this through education, training and support with housing, employment and health. We offer one to one support, advice, and courses for homeless people in 12 areas across England, Scotland and Wales.
