Can I sleep at a Christmas centre?

Please make your own way to the centre if you can.

Minibus pick-up times (from point 1 on each route):

23 December
First pick-up 11am.
Last pick-up 3pm.

24 - 29 December
First pick-up 9am.
Last pick-up 12noon.

You should not have to wait more than an hour for a bus.

Minibuses collect our guests from pick-up points around London and take them to our day centres.

How do I get there?

To make Crisis at Christmas safe and enjoyable for everyone, we don't allow the following in our centres:

Most of our guests do not stay overnight. If you do not have anywhere to sleep, please speak to a team leader at a day centre. We have some residential centres for people with the most urgent need.

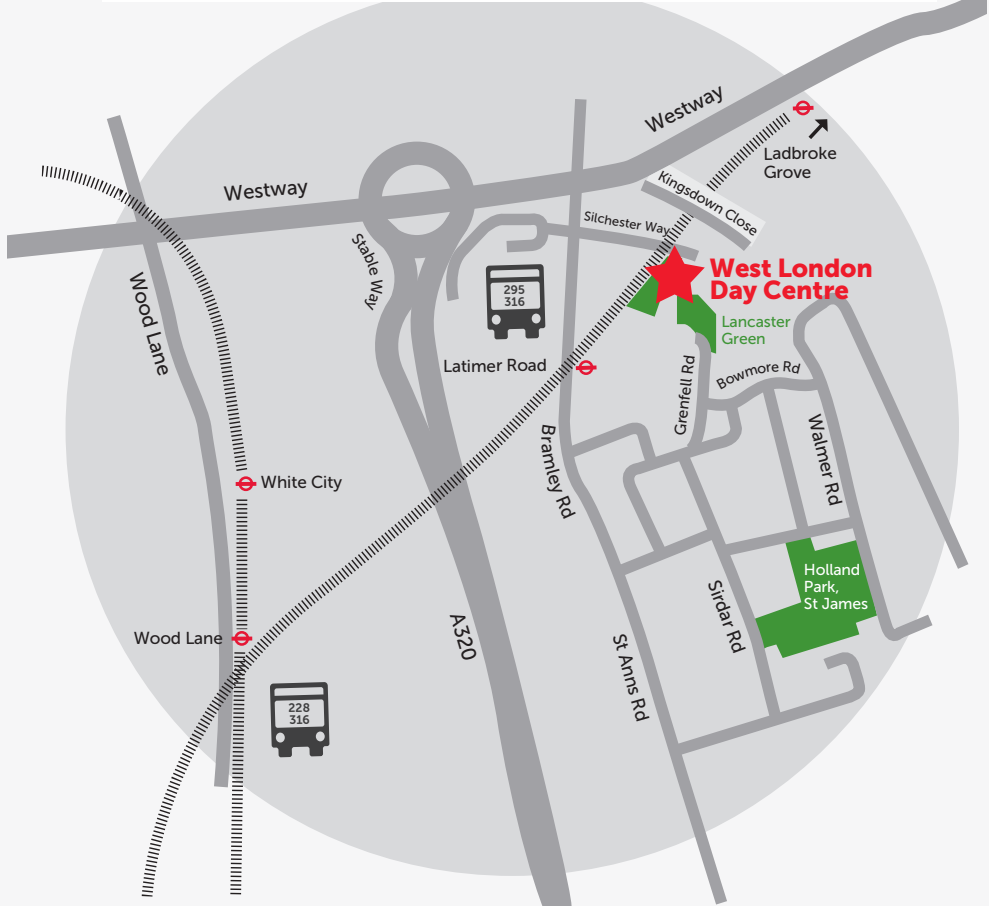
