here are many incredible people who are helping us put an end to homelessness. Chris is one of our valued supporters who has kindly remembered Crisis in his Will.


"There was a guy that worked for me, his marriage collapsed, and he ended up on the streets. We didn't know what had happened to him until someone saw him asleep in a bus shelter. It brought it home to me just how short that path can be, between living in a safe, secure and warm home, to literally being on the streets. It really struck a chord.

"During the summer, Morrisons were donating food to local causes. I was collecting food one day, and someone from work saw me coming out of the store with a big bag of pasta. She said, **'you should tell us all how we can help, and if you don't, you're preventing us from helping.'** So I emailed everybody at work and got a great response. "Kindness unlocks things in other people, and in my experience, it's becoming more instantaneous. Collectively we can make a difference.

"Coming into this year, I decided I needed to sort my Will out, and I wanted a worthy charity to benefit. When I looked at Crisis' mission statement I thought, 'that's right, that's what we should be doing. I thought it'd be complicated, but writing my Will was really, really simple. The whole thing happened in days.

"In my experience, it isn't one trigger that pushes people into homelessness, it's a series of events, and now it feels inevitable that things will get worse before they get better. It's good to know that organisations like Crisis, with the approach they're taking, will make a difference to people who are homeless."

Planning your Will

hank you so much for considering a gift in your Will to Crisis. We are so grateful to anyone who supports us in this way.

We understand that making a Will or changing an existing one might seem complicated, but it's easier than you might think. These simple steps will help guide you through the process:

What

Write down what you own (property, savings, valuables) and work out a rough value.

Who

Decide who you want to benefit (family, friends, charity).

Which

Pick which type of gift you want to leave each recipient:

Pecuniary gift – A specific sum of money, e.g. £1,000 **Residuary gift** – A percentage or fraction of your estate, e.g. 1/10 or 10%

How

Arrange to see a solicitor who can draft your Will for you. Or go to **www.farewill.com/crisis** where you can write your Will for free with the code: **Remember-Crisis**

Any gift you leave to help support people experiencing homelessness will be gratefully received, and will have a real and lasting impact.

Laura's story

very year, Crisis works with thousands of people to support them on their journey out of homelessness. Laura is one of these individuals and this is her story.

Laura was studying art at University when her mum passed away from cancer. Laura struggled with the loss and turned to alcohol. She didn't get any help with bereavement or with her growing alcohol addiction. She said: "If you don't get help, you escape from what's going on inside you. That's what I did. I left to move to another city with a lot of sadness and pain inside. My alcohol addiction escalated. I went to a really bad place. I was sofa surfing between cities for between six months to a year. It made me feel really anxious and depressed.

"There was a lot of worry about what the next day would bring. It's so temporary. You are living on someone's sofa in their lounge, in their environment. People were nice to me, but you have no base camp, no place to belong and that's really hard. "I tried to stop drinking, but suffered a seizure. I ended up in re-hab and when I left, because I had nowhere to go, I went into a dry women's shelter. That's where everything changed for me. There was a brochure with courses that Crisis were running, and I decided to enrol in the weekly art and podcasting classes.

"The courses have helped me grow in confidence, but I was also able to get practical support and work with business coaches. That has helped me secure my own flat and follow my passion for being creative.

"I'm trying to develop my illustration business now. I would never have had the confidence to do that without the support I've received from Crisis. I can't thank the coaches, volunteers and everyone who supports Crisis enough. It's totally changed my life."

You can write your Will from the comfort of your own home in as little as 20 minutes, with expert support available if you need it. Important questions

What if I already have a Will?

It's important to review your Will from time to time, to make sure it still reflects your wishes. This can be a good opportunity to add a gift to Crisis. When you write a new Will it revokes any previous Wills. So if you used a solicitor to write your Will before, they will write a new one with any additional changes you request.

How much can make a difference?

Every gift makes a difference. Whatever you feel comfortable leaving really helps and will be gratefully received.

How can I find a solicitor?

Contact the Law Society on 020 7320 5650 or visit www.lawsociety.org.uk and select 'Find a Solicitor' to find a registered legal professional in your area.

Who should I choose as an executor?

It's entirely up to you. You can choose an individual you know well, or a professional such as a solicitor or financial advisor. Please note that professional Executors may charge for their services.

Are there any tax benefits?

Charitable legacies are usually exempt from Inheritance Tax and currently, if you leave more than 10% of your estate to charity, Inheritance Tax is reduced further. Always consult a professional for financial advice specific to you.

How much will it cost?

It varies, depending on how complex your Will is. However, the average cost is between £100 – £200. To write your Will for free online, go to **www.farewill.com/crisis** and use the voucher code: **Remember-Crisis**.
