To end homelessness

The Journeys Home Fund aims to bring together a small community of philanthropists, united by the mission of ending homelessness. By 2024, our goal is to help nearly 600 people end homelessness in their lives, for good.

More and more people with complex support needs are coming to Crisis for help, but face waiting times to access our services that are too long. If we can't provide **the right support at the right time**, we risk people 'dropping out' or getting stuck in potentially dangerous and traumatic circumstances.

The scale of homelessness in this country means that we have come to a pivotal moment. If we don't **act now**, we could see more people than ever before facing homelessness. That's why – through the Journeys Home Fund – Crisis is investing in a new way of providing its services.

By providing every individual who makes use of Crisis services with a consistent key point of contact, for the first time our coaches will be able to offer wraparound one-to-one support, helping empower people who are experiencing homelessness to move into secure and stable housing as quickly as possible.

By pioneering this new approach, we will be able to deepen the impact we have in individuals' lives and ensure that every step someone takes with Crisis is geared towards helping them leave homelessness behind. It will also mean that people do not have to repeat their story each time they engage with a different part of our services; this can be distressing and ultimately risks setting back the progress someone has already made.

The Journeys Home Fund will not only help hundreds of people change their lives for the better, but will also lay down a critical part of the blueprint for how Crisis provides its services nationally. The Fund is a collaborative effort between Crisis, supporters, and people with lived experience of homelessness. Our first goal is to raise £1.18m, every penny of which goes directly towards the newly formed 'structured coaching' team based at our London Skylight centre.

Crisis is the national charity for homeless people. By backing us you become part of an organisation that has over 50 years' experience tackling the injustice of homelessness. But we can't do this alone. And we don't intend to be needed 50 years from now.
