
About Micro Rainbow

Micro Rainbow is the leading organisation in the UK promoting safety and integration of LGBTQI asylum seekers and refugees holistically.

Our approach has three main pillars:



LGBTQI people fleeing persecution



- 67 jurisdictions criminalise same-sex sexual activity.
- 11 have the death penalty. At least 6 of these implement it: Iran, Northern Nigeria, Saudi Arabia, Somalia and Yemen
- 15 criminalise the gender identity and/or expression of transgender people



LGBTQI people fleeing persecution

2.2 billion people live in countries where being gay is a crime of which 210 million could be LGBTQI

Up to **2,000** LGBTQI people claim asylum in the UK every year.

Experience and fear of:

- Imprisonment
- Name-calling
- Beating
- Harassment
- Community mobbing
- Lashes
- Torture by family members, community

- Honour killing
- Death penalty
- Persecution from religious authorities
- Torture by authorities
- Rape
- Death threats
- Humiliation
- Forced marriage
- No police protection / Police abuse
- Self harm



Arriving in the UK

When LGBTQI+ people come to the UK to seek safety they are still not safe. They face:

- Homelessness
- Violence
- Socio-economic exclusion
- A lengthy asylum process
- Difficulties in accessing experienced legal support



Why are LGBTQI migrants homeless?

- Lack of social safety net from their ethnic communities due to their LGBTQI+ status for fear of honor killing and/or potential persecution if their asylum claim is rejected
- Escaping traffickers, domestic violence/forced marriages
- Lack of expert legal representation

Why are LGBTQI+ migrants homeless?

- Violence in NASS accommodation
- Often LGBTQI+ migrants have to hide their sexuality if they are given shelter by family members or conationals/violence abuse if discovered
- If their hosts find out about their LGBTQI+ status they can be rejected/evicted/disowned.


