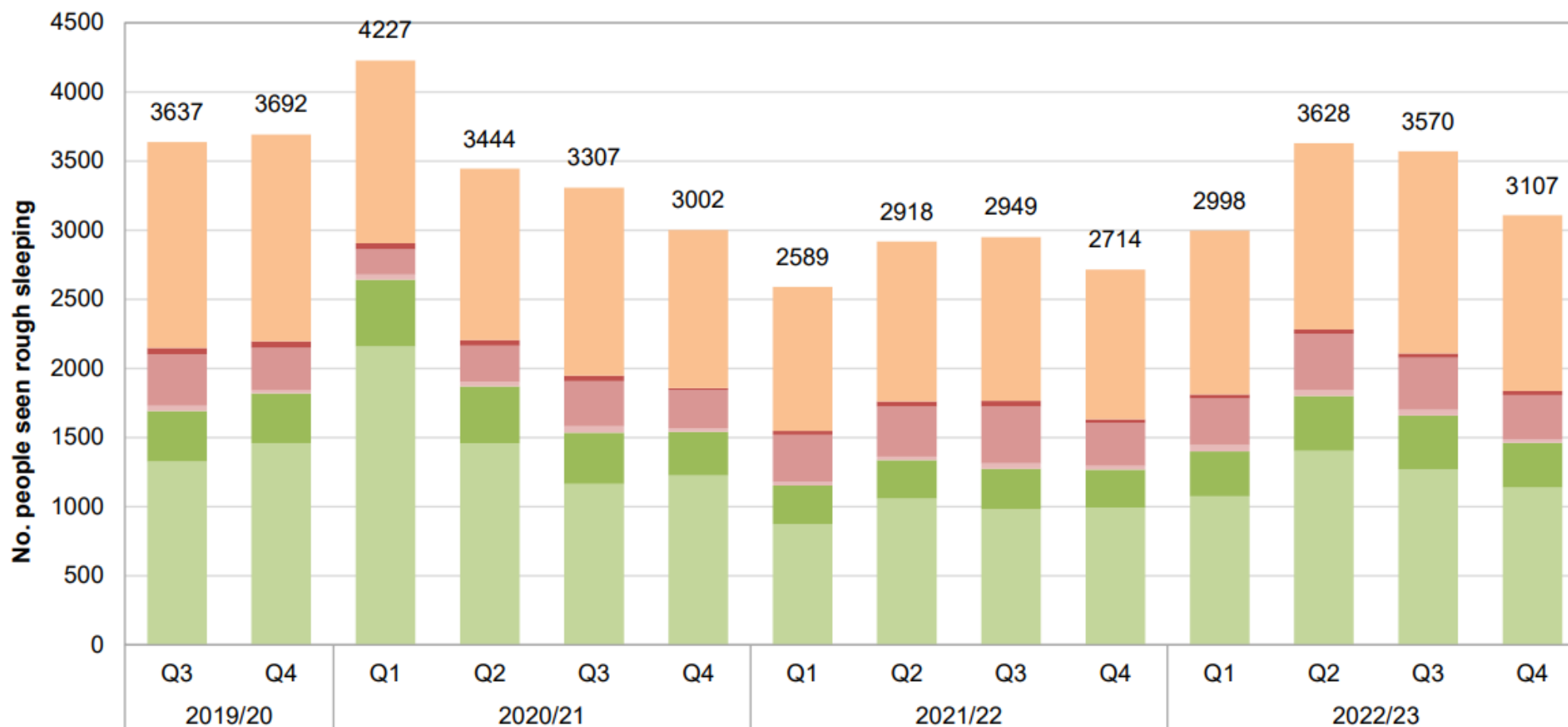

# Glossary

Term	Definition
New rough sleepers	Those who had not been contacted by outreach teams rough sleeping before the quarter
Living on the streets	Those who have had a high number of contacts over 3 weeks or more which suggests they are living on the streets
Intermittent rough sleepers	People who were seen rough sleeping before the quarter began at some point, and contacted in the period - but not regularly enough to be 'living on the streets'
NSNO	No Second Night Out
RS	Rough Sleeper
LOS	Living on the Streets

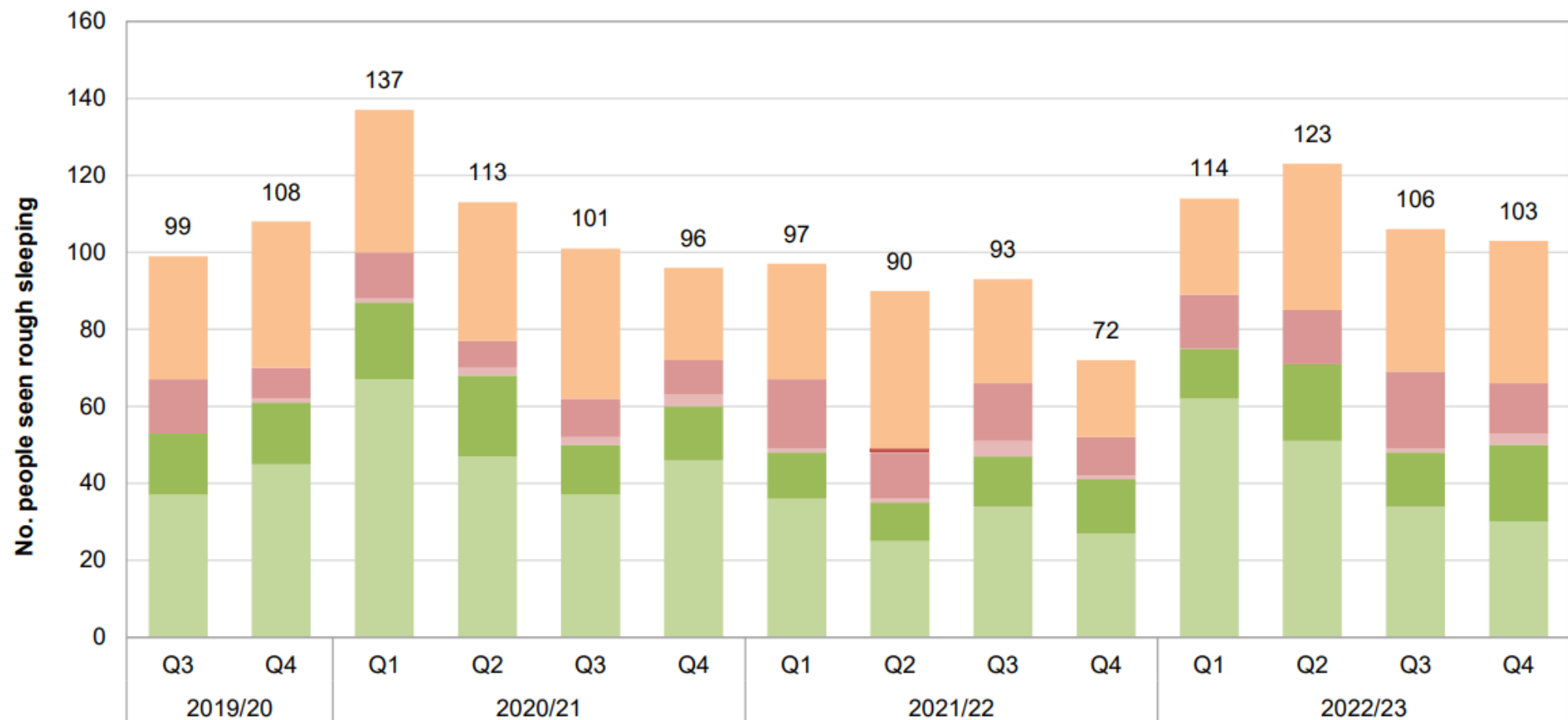
### 3.1 People seen rough sleeping in London, by type, since 2019/20 Q3

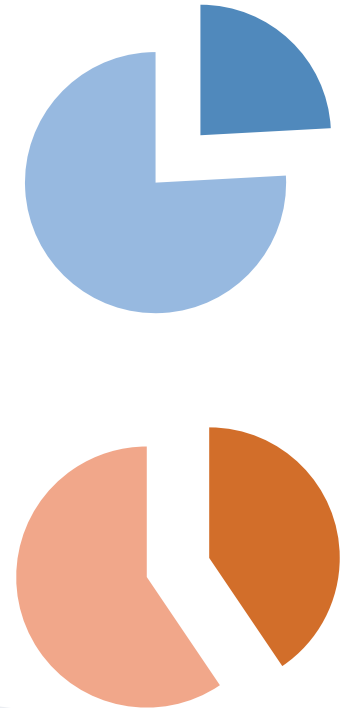
